To be awarded by the NYS ID/DD Nurses Association Applications Due: April 1, 2024

PLEASE SHARE

The New York State ID/DD Nurses Association is awarding two \$1,000 scholarships to encourage RNs, LPNs, DSPs, and other staff members currently working in the in the field of intellectual/ developmental disabilities to explore or remain in the field of ID/DD nursing. One scholarship will be awarded to an RN who is pursuing a BSN degree, and one scholarship will be awarded to an LPN, Direct Support Staff (DSP), or other non-nurse staff member who is currently matriculated in an accredited RN program.

TO BE ELIGIBLE: Candidates must be a New York State resident and must meet these criteria:

For the RN to BSN Scholarship:

- Is an RN who is currently working or has previously worked in the intellectual/ developmental disabilities field and is matriculated in an accredited BSN program.
- Plans to work as an ID/DD nurse in New York State upon graduation.

For the LPN/DSP/other non-nurse staff member to RN Scholarship:

- Is a DSP, LPN, or other non-nurse staff member who is currently working or has previously worked in the intellectual/developmental disabilities field and is currently matriculated in an accredited RN program.
- Plans to work as an ID/DD nurse in New York State upon graduation.

TO APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP: Complete the fillable application, which is available on the NYSIDDDNA website at https://www.nysidddna.org/scholarship/. You will be asked to respond to each statement below. We are especially interested in learning about your interest and experience working in the ID/DD field, your future educational and professional goals, and your education and work experience.

- 1. Introduce yourself and your interest in the intellectual/developmental disabilities field.
- 2. Describe your future educational and professional goals. (No more than 500 words)
- 3. List your education and your work experience relevant to your work in the ID/DD field.
- 4. Provide proof of current matriculation in an RN or BSN program.
 - For the LPN/DSP to RN Scholarship: Matriculation documentation must be a letter or verification on school letterhead from the Nursing Program or from the College Registrar's Office. Note: A college transcript or course listing is not sufficient for proof of matriculation.
 - For the RN to BSN Scholarship: Matriculation documentation can be a letter of program acceptance with current proof of course enrollment (course receipt) **OR** a letter or verification on school letterhead from the Nursing Program or the College Registrar's Office.

TO SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION: After you complete the application form, email your application and documentation of matriculation to the NYS ID/DD Nurses Association at information@nysidddna.org.

The scholarships will be awarded in June 2024. The scholarship recipients will be chosen from the eligible applicants by a selection committee of the NYS ID/DD Nurses Association.
